In which of the following cases are Rich and Brenda saying the same thing, and in which are they saying different things?

1. Rich: "Scallions are sort of like onions."  
Brenda: "Onions are sort of like scallions."
2. Rich: "Stu is different from Lou."  
Brenda: "Lou is different from Stu."
3. Rich: "Patricia is not as happy as Linda."  
Brenda: "Linda is happier than Patricia"
4. Rich: "Rich people have more money than poor people."  
Brenda: "Poor people have less money than rich people."
5. Rich: "The tide is out, but it looks like it's in."  
Brenda: "The tide looks like it's out, but it's in."
6. Rich: "Marianne is close to her boyfriend, Pete."  
Brenda: "Marianne and her boyfriend, Pete, are very close."
7. Rich: "Joe is older than he looks."  
Brenda: "Joe looks younger than he really is."
8. Rich: "I think Jack is smarter than he looks."  
Brenda: "I think Jack looks smarter than he really is."
