
The core course

SAPERE offers a professional learning pathway that develops beginner, intermediate and advanced P4C practice.

The pathway consists of courses at three levels.

Each course covers six compulsory modules which address essential aspects of good P4C practice.

Those who complete all six modules at each level, receive a certificate of attendance.

Module Five : Evaluate P4C What constitutes progress and participation in P4C? How can P4C support metacognition?

How does P4C work in other educational contexts? How do I address problems arising in my P4C practice?

LEVEL 3 Advanced P4C Practitioner

Module One: Experience P4C How do diverse practices of P4C compare? What is it like to be challenged as a P4C participant?

Module Two: Theorise P4C What are some of the criticisms of P4C? How is philosophical scholarship on P4C evolving?

Module Three: Plan P4C How can I refine my existing P4C planning? How do I plan more ambitious P4C projects?

Module Four : Facilitate P4C What are the biggest challenges of P4C facilitation? How can facilitators address controversial issues?

Module Five : Evaluate P4C How can current research improve my P4C practice? How can my practice contribute to new research?

Module Six: Apply P4C How does P4C vary by age, ability and subject? How can I apply my practice in new or novel settings?

The complete course

We encourage delegates to take two further selfdirected modules that focus on practice and evidence.

Those who complete these courses receive a Certificate of Achievement.


Bespoke courses






